## **Martifer Solar Signs Framework Agreement with Enfinity**

Martifer, through Martifer-Solar, today signed a framework agreement covering the installation of up to 30MWp of PV installations in Belgium. This agreement was signed with Belgium group Enfinity, with whom Martifer already has a contract to deliver several solar parks in Spain totaling 8MWp.

This second contract strengthens the relationship between both groups and opens good perspectives for future developments. These installations will start to be installed in 2008. The size varies between 100kWp and 2MWp and will be installed on rooftops of commercial and industrial buildings.

This market sector is significant in countries like Germany, France, Italy and Spain, and soon also in Portugal, as a result of the recent legislation regarding rooftop generation. Martifer will be incorporating a company under Belgium law for this purpose, adding one more country to those where the Group is present, totaling now 17 countries.

Martifer-Solar is building a solar photovoltaic modules factory in Portugal, with an initial installed capacity of 50MW, which will deliver the first modules in October this year. During 2009, Martifer-Solar will double the output of the factory, and in 2010, a production of 100MW of PV modules is expected.
